## Onomichi/尾道

## Vodka, unfiltered sake, spicy ginger sirup, sparkling water and lime

This take on a Tokyo mule is named after a donkey farm on top of a small hill overlooking the Seto sea near Onomichi Japan and it kicks just like a mule.

## Paris Syndrome / 1911/

### Gin, yuzu, sparkling sake & grapefruit

Appropriately named after a transient mental disorder occurring almost exclusively to Japanese tourists visiting Paris. This is a Nipponese twist on the strong, classic French 75, cocktail.

## The Kurosawa / 黒澤

This Lulu version of a classic espresso martini is an homage to one of the greatest filmmakers in history, Akira Kurosawa.

Having a hard time adapting to color he preferred black and white photography, just like the colors of this cocktail. Kurosawa also means «black swamp» in English, you get it?

## Nikkei Sour / ニッケイサワー

#### Pisco, black sesame & aji amarillo

Developing on from the famous Pisco sour this twist uses an earthy Quebranta grape Pisco alongside toasted black sesame, Amarillo chili & kombu seaweed bitters, creating an exciting combination that is even silkier than the classic. **(S)** 

## Komako Spritz/ 小牧 スプライト

#### Umeshu, grapefruit, lemon & mint

Umeshu spritzer is named after the classic Japanese novel 'Snow Country's main character and her bittersweet story. A light, fresh, built cocktail. (S) as a garnish, so can be made without)

## Culu/ JUJU

#### Rum, Umeshu, Vanilla and lime.

An outstanding example of a particular person or a thing.

This our take on a classic daiquiri, and as far as daiquiris go, this one is a Lulu.

Allergen/Dietary guide - Hazelnuts (H), Almonds (A), Peanuts (P), Pistachio (PI), Sesame (S) Pinenuts (PN) & no drinks contain egg white since we use a vegan alternative.
